Preliminary ideas

- Practical online support tool, based on findings IO1, IO2, IO3
- Not a strict guideline, but more a knowledge hub, which inspires and gives new ideas
- Gives background information on current situation
- Highlights different challenges
- Step-for step-approach, including development of a project plan, building alliances with different stakeholders, involving the target group, etc
- Linkage to practical examples

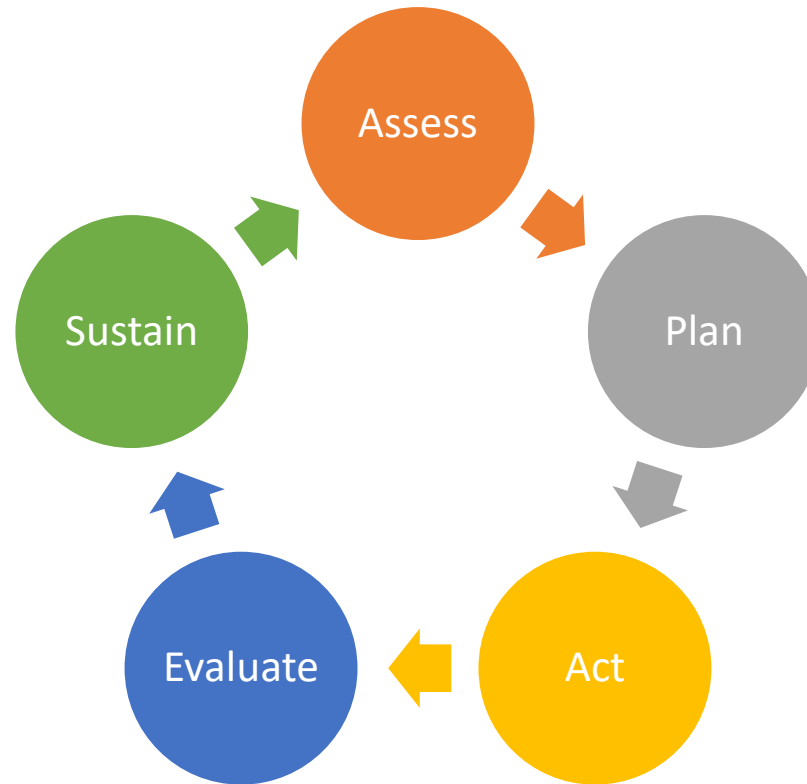
Introduction
